

2009-2010 Minnesota ACS State Championships Competition Entry Guidelines:

General Guidelines:

1. The 2009-2010 Minnesota ACS 9-Ball and 8-Ball Singles Championships will be held on March 11-14, 2010, and Mixed Scotch Doubles and Team Championship will be held on April 15-18, 2010.
2. Entries **MUST** be sent to your local ACS league operator. Entry fees are to be paid to your local ACS league, which in turn will pay the Minnesota ACS, by check, for all entries from your league.
3. Entries **MUST** be postmarked by date specified on the entry form. Late entries **WILL NOT** be accepted!
4. All players must be part of an ACS-sanctioned league, and must have played in at least six league matches during the 2009-2010 league season. This criteria must be met for all MNACS Championship competition.
5. Player placements and ranking may be subject to change prior to the tournament as seen fit by the MNACS Ranking Committee.
6. Every Player is responsible for verifying their match times. There will be a 15-minute grace period on match times. Absences longer than 15-minutes will result in forfeiture of the match.
7. Every player must abide by the dress code. Although there is no official dress code, no shorts, sweat pants, tank tops, or "poor taste" clothing will be allowed. It is at the discrepancy of the tournament director as to the dress code.
8. Requests for refunds must be made in writing and submitted before the day of the tournament. Refund checks will be issued from the MNACS after the tournament.
9. All players receiving prize money must have picture ID to collect winnings.
10. Failure to comply with ACS or MNACS rules and regulations may be cause for disqualification from the event.

Singles 9-Ball and 8-Ball Guidelines:

1. Singles 9-ball competition will begin on Thursday, March 11th at 8 pm for all divisions. Singles 8-ball competition will begin on Friday, March 12 at 8 pm for all open divisions. Masters will begin play at noon on Saturday, March 13th. It is the player's responsibility to know their match times. All times and tournament charts will be posted one hour prior to designated start time of events. Player check-in is not required.
2. Refer to General Guidelines for additional information.

Team and Mixed Scotch Doubles Guidelines:

1. Mixed Scotch Doubles competition will begin at 8 pm on Thursday April 15th, 2010. Team competition will begin Friday, April 16th at 8 pm for all Open divisions. Masters play will begin on Saturday, April 17th @ Noon. It is the player's responsibility to know their match times. All times and tournament charts will be posted one hour prior to designated start time of events. Team check-in is not required.
2. Teams must consist of players from the same league. During each match, at least three players must have played on and satisfied eligibility on the **SAME LEAGUE TEAM**.
3. Masters teams may be made up of any caliber five or more players from the same league. All other divisions must consist of players with that rated ability, with a maximum of one player rated one level higher than the division played. All teams will be subject to being "bumped" into a higher division upon reviewal of the placement committee.
4. Roster changes will be allowed only with proof of eligibility and must be made by 7:00pm on Friday, April 16th.
5. Matching team shirts are not required. However, MNACS dress code will be enforced for all participants.
6. Refer to General Guidelines for additional information and guidelines.

All players will conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the positive image of pool. Any player(s) conducting themselves in a manner deemed unprofessional may be disqualified at the discrepancy of the Tournament Director.
