

2010-2011 Minnesota ACS State Championships Competition Entry Guidelines:

General Guidelines:

1. The 2010-2011 Minnesota ACS 8-Ball Singles Championships and Team Championship will be held on March 17-20, 2011.
2. Entries should be sent to the address at the bottom of the entry form. Please make sure you have checked the **MN ACS** player **check box** at the bottom of the form.
3. Entries **MUST** be postmarked by date specified on the entry form. Late entries **WILL NOT** be accepted!
4. All players must be part of an ACS-sanctioned league, and must have played in at least six league matches during the 2010-2011 league season. This criteria must be met for all MNACS Championship competition.
5. Player placements and ranking may be subject to change prior to the tournament as seen fit by the MNACS Ranking Committee.
6. Every Player is responsible for verifying their match times. There will be a 15-minute grace period on match times. Absences longer than 15-minutes will result in forfeiture of the match.
7. Every player must abide by the dress code. Although there is no official dress code, but no shorts, sweat pants, tank tops, or "poor taste" clothing will be allowed. It is at the discrepancy of the tournament director as to the dress code.
8. Requests for refunds must be made in writing and submitted before the day of the tournament. Refund checks will be issued from the MNACS after the tournament.
9. All players receiving prize money must have picture ID to collect winnings.
10. Failure to comply with ACS or MNACS rules and regulations may be cause for disqualification from the event.

Singles 8-Ball Guidelines:

1. Singles 8-ball competition will begin on Thursday, March 17 at 7 pm for all divisions. It is the player's responsibility to know their match times. All times and tournament charts will be posted one hour prior to designated start time of events. Player check-in is required, Players must have a Treasure Island Player Card prior to checking in, Treasure Island personnel will be available prior to the tournament start for players convivance.

Team Guidelines:

1. Team competition will begin Friday, March 18th at 7 pm for all Open divisions. Masters play will begin on Saturday, March 19th @ Noon. It is the player's responsibility to know their match times. All times and tournament charts will be posted one hour prior to designated start time of events. Team check-in is not required.
2. **Teams must consist of three players from the same team. During each match, at least three players must have played on and same team to satisfied eligibility, remaining players do not have to be from the same ACS League, but they must play on an ACS sanctioned league and meet the singles eligibility.**
3. Masters teams may be made up of any caliber five or more players from **any ACS sanctioned league**. All other divisions must consist of players with that rated ability, with a maximum of one player rated one level higher than the division played. All teams will be subject to being "bumped" into a higher division upon reviewal of the placement committee.
4. Roster changes will be allowed only with proof of eligibility and must be made by 6:00pm on Friday, March 19th.
5. Matching team shirts are not required. However, MNACS dress code will be enforced for all participants.

All players will conduct themselves in a manner that reflects the positive image of pool. Any player(s) conducting themselves in a manner deemed unprofessional may be disqualified at the discrepancy of the Tournament Director.
